GENERAL:

- Background:
A Parkway is a road corridor with regionally outstanding scenic, natural, recreational, cultural, historic, or archeological significance. Unlike Arterial Roads and Interstate Highways which emphasize direct, efficient travel routes, Parkways are typically controlled access highway roads which contain additional resources, features, and facilities which heighten the travel experience. NY State Parkways are designed specifically for passenger vehicle use. Some parkways, particularly in Long Island, are constructed with low arch bridges to physically prevent truck access.

Under normal circumstances oversize/overweight commercial vehicles are not allowed to use Parkways, however it is allowed in some instances. This includes construction and/or repair of the Parkway or if use of the Parkway is the only way to access the pickup/delivery point.

If you propose to route your trip over a Parkway, prior to submission of your Special Hauling Permit application, you will need to contact the appropriate agency (noted below) for approval. Once approval is obtained and a permit or written approval is issued, you can submit the permit/approval with your Special Hauling Permit application. Failure to submit an approved Parkway permit or written approval with your Special Hauling Permit application will result in a disapproval of your application.
