**DESCRIPTION**

This work shall consist of the removal and disposal of boulders from specific locations as shown on the Contract Documents or where directed by the Engineer.

**MATERIALS**

Not applicable.

**CONSTRUCTION DETAILS**

The Contractor shall remove each boulder from the locations indicated in the Contract Documents or where ordered by the Engineer. The Contractor will have the option of either removing the boulders or breaking up the boulders by blasting or other means. If the boulder is broken up, all fragments that in the opinion of the Engineer are potentially unstable shall be removed and disposed of by the Contractor.

All disturbed areas shall be smoothed and trimmed to reasonably match adjacent ground surfaces. All disturbed areas shall be seeded and mulched in accordance with the requirements of section 610.

**METHOD OF MEASUREMENT**

Quantities shall be the volume of the boulder(s), in cubic meters, computed in the original position, as measured by the Engineer.

**BASIS OF PAYMENT**

The unit price bid for these items shall include the cost of furnishing all equipment, labor and materials as necessary to do the work. All incidental work, such as rock drilling and blasting, trimming disturbed areas, establishing turf on disturbed areas, precautionary measures to protect the highway surface or private property shall be included in the unit price.
