

**ITEM 560.1710 08 – REMOVE AND RELOCATE EXISTING MASONRY AND
IRON GATE**

DESCRIPTION:

Under this item the contractor shall remove and relocate existing masonry gate to the location shown on the plans and as directed by the Engineer. All work shall be done in accordance with these specifications and in reasonably close conformity with the lines and grades shown on the plans or established by the Engineer.

All reference to "gate" shall include existing brick, masonry, wrought iron gate, electric and all components to be removed and relocated.

MATERIALS:

The existing gate and its components shall be used for the relocated gate.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

The contractor shall carefully remove and relocate the existing gate to the location shown on the plans or as directed by the Engineer. The contractor may choose to use the existing footings or pour new Class A reinforced concrete footings. The new footing design shall be approved by the Engineer.

Any damage done to the gate, caused by the Contractor's operations, shall be repaired at no expense to the State.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:

The removal and relocation of the existing gate will be made on a lump sum basis for work satisfactorily completed.

BASIS OF PAYMENT:

The lump sum price bid shall include the cost of furnishing all materials, labor and equipment necessary to satisfactorily complete the work as specified.

Any new concrete footings, footing excavation, grading and associated materials shall be included in the price for this item.
