

ITEM 11607.9401 M - REMOVE AND REINSTALL WROUGHT IRON FENCE

DESCRIPTION:

Under this item, the Contractor shall remove and reinstall fencing where shown on the plans. All work shall be done in accordance with these specifications and in reasonably close conformity with the lines and grades shown on the plans or established by the Engineer.

All reference to "fencing" shall include existing wrought iron fence panels, posts and gates, if any, to be removed and reinstalled.

MATERIALS:

The existing fencing shall be used for the reinstalled fencing. All removed fencing shall be stored in a location approved by the Engineer.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

1. Fence Removal. The Contractor shall carefully remove the existing fencing and clean and store all materials for re-use. All work shall be done in a workmanlike manner with care taken not to disturb the surrounding area and existing fence to remain. Any damage done to the fencing to be reinstalled, caused by the Contractor's operations, shall be repaired to the original condition at no expense to the State.

2. Fence Reinstallation. The fence shall be set vertically and to the required grade and alignment. The fence shall be anchored in a manner approved by the Engineer.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:

Payment for removing and relocating wrought iron fencing will be made on a lump sum basis.

BASIS OF PAYMENT:

The lump sum price for removing and relocating wrought iron fencing shall include all equipment, materials and labor required to satisfactorily complete the work, including necessary excavation.

Fifty percent (50%) of the price bid shall be paid after satisfactory removal of the wrought iron fencing. The remaining fifty percent (50%) shall be paid after completion of the relocation of wrought iron fence to the satisfaction of the Engineer.
