

ITEM 10608.020501 M - ASPHALT CONCRETE SIDEWALKS, DRIVEWAYS AND BICYCLE PATHS (GRADING INCLUDED)

ITEM 10608.020511 M - PLANT PRODUCTION QUALITY ADJUSTMENT TO 10608.020501M

DESCRIPTION

The work shall consist of the construction of asphalt concrete sidewalks, driveways, and bicycle paths and necessary grading as shown on the plans.

MATERIALS

The following requirements of Sections 203 and 608 shall apply: 203-2.02A, 608-2, and 608-2.02.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

The requirements of Subsection 203-3.12 shall apply to the placement of embankment.

The requirements of Subsection 608-3.02 shall apply in addition to the following:

The location of asphalt concrete sidewalks, driveways, and bicycle paths shall be properly graded to conform with the sidewalk, driveway, or bicycle path cross-section and line and grade. The graded area shall be firm and dry before placing the asphalt and all organic or unstable materials, existing curbs, sidewalks, and driveways shall be removed.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

This work will be measured by the number of metric tons of asphalt concrete furnished and incorporated in the work. Quality payment adjustments will be measured as outlined in Subsection 402-4, "Method of Measurement."

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The unit price bid per metric ton shall include all excavation, embankment, preparation of subgrade, and all other materials, equipment, and labor necessary to complete the work as called for on the plans and to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

No separate payment will be made for excavation or embankment above, below, or within the volume of asphalt concrete sidewalks, driveways, and bicycle paths placed.

Payment of Quality Units will be made based on the Index Price listed in the contract documents. The index price shown in the itemized proposal for each Quality Unit shall be considered the price bid. The unit (index) price is not to be altered in any manner by the bidder. Should the bidder alter the amount shown, the altered figure will be disregarded and the original price will be used to determine the total amount bid for the Contract.
