

ITEM 10615.0310 M - WATERING VEGETATION - (MINIMUM BID SPECIFIED)

DESCRIPTION:

This work shall include watering plants, shrubs, ground covers, vines and other plants as specified in the contract documents and as specified in Section 615 - Landscape Miscellaneous.

MATERIALS:

The materials shall meet the requirements of Subsection 712-01 Water.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS:

Water shall be applied as specified in the contract documents and Subsection 615-3.01. All watering shall be accomplished using a 25 mm inside diameter hose with breaker or watering probe. The Contractor shall supply a minimum 9400L tank equipped with a flow meter and 100 m of hose and a power driven pump adequately powered to efficiently supply water to plants. Water shall be applied at low pressure directly to each planting pit without disturbing soil and or mulch. No watering shall begin until the contractor submits a schedule of watering, and receives written approval from the E.I.C.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT:

This work will be measured in kiloliters of water applied. The quantity applied will be determined from an approved flow meter. The Contractor shall furnish the Engineer's representative with measurements and capacities to provide a complete and accurate record of the quantity of water furnished and applied.

BASIS OF PAYMENT:

Payment for this work will be at a minimum bid price of \$18.00 per kiloliter of water supplied. This amount will be automatically entered and the bid total adjusted if the Contractor enters a bid for a lesser amount. The Contractor may choose to enter a higher bid.

The unit price bid shall include the cost of furnishing and applying water, all labor, equipment and incidentals necessary to satisfactorily complete the work. No compensation will be allowed for water improperly dispensed or excess watering as determined by the Engineer.
