

## **ITEM 10615.1204 M - CLEANING PAVEMENT SURFACES TO IMPROVE BICYCLE SAFETY**

### **DESCRIPTION**

This work shall consist of cleaning pavement surfaces free of dirt and debris by sweeping or other methods. This includes any pick up and proper disposal of debris on the pavement whose removal is necessary to perform the cleaning operation. It is intended for cleaning highway shoulder pavement to improve bicycle safety.

### **MATERIALS**

None Specified.

### **CONSTRUCTION DETAILS**

Equipment for cleaning pavement surfaces may be selected by the Contractor, but shall be subject to the approval of the Engineer and shall conform to all applicable local, state and federal laws, regulations and codes. The work required to clean pavement surfaces shall be performed in accordance with these specifications, the contract documents and to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

The full width of the highway shoulder pavement used as a bicycle route or intersecting a local bicycle route shall be cleaned. Highway shoulder pavement used as bicycle routes and highway shoulder pavement intersecting local bicycle routes on both sides of the mainline pavement shall be cleaned within the work limits shown in the contract documents or as directed by the Engineer.

The Contractor shall clean highway shoulder pavement used as bicycle routes and highway shoulder pavement intersecting local bicycle routes at the times and intervals as specified in the Schedule of Operations as shown in the plans or as ordered by the Engineer. The Contractor shall notify the Engineer 48 hours before any work is begun.

The Contractor shall supply all necessary flags, signs, and other devices to maintain and protect bike traffic. Work shall be conducted in such a manner that the pavement surface shall not be damaged or left in a way that will mislead or misdirect cyclists. Any pavement damaged by the Contractor's operations shall be repaired by the Contractor at no expense to the State. All pavement surfaces shall be cleaned in the required manner. All pavement sweepings shall be removed and disposed of legally off the work site as approved by the Engineer.

### **METHOD OF MEASUREMENT**

Cleaning of pavement surfaces will be measured on a kilometer basis each time the pavement surface is cleaned.

### **BASIS OF PAYMENT**

The unit price bid shall include the cost of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work and shall include removal and satisfactory disposal of debris. Highway shoulder pavement used as a bicycle route or intersecting a local bicycle route will be measured separately on both sides of the mainline pavement for payment. No separate payment will be made for maintenance and protection of traffic but this cost is to be included in the price bid for cleaning the pavement surfaces. No payment will be made for cleaning any location until cleaning is performed along the entire length of the location for the month specified.
