

ITEM 10615.1303 M - CLEANING OF PAVEMENT SURFACES (REST AREA)

DESCRIPTION

This work shall consist of cleaning concrete and bituminous pavement surfaces, including entrances and pedestrian walkways within the rest areas.

MATERIALS

None Specified.

CONSTRUCTION DETAILS

Equipment for cleaning pavement surfaces may be selected by the Contractor, but shall be subject to the approval of the Engineer and shall conform to all applicable local, state and federal laws, regulations and codes. The work required to clean pavement surfaces shall be performed in accordance with these specifications, the contract documents and to the satisfaction of the Engineer. The Contractor shall notify the Engineer 48 hours before any work is begun.

The Contractor shall supply all necessary flags, signs, and other devices to maintain and protect traffic. When the work is conducted under traffic, the Contractor shall supply all necessary flags, markers, signs and other devices to maintain and protect traffic. The Contractor is to restrict parking in half the rest area lot by the use of cones, barrels, and signs to allow for cleaning and sweeping the closed area. The Contractor shall close, clean and sweep the other half of the lot the next day.

The Contractor may request permission from the Engineer to clean pavement at a time when few or no cars would be present. Work shall be conducted in such a manner that the pavement surface shall not be damaged or left in a way that will mislead or misdirect motorists.

The pavement surface shall be swept after debris is removed under the item for Removal of Litter (Rest Area). All sweepings from the rest area shall be removed and disposed of legally off the work site as approved by the Engineer. The Contractor shall clean each rest area at the times and intervals as specified in the Schedule of Operations as shown in the plans or as ordered by the Engineer.

METHOD OF MEASUREMENT

Cleaning of rest area pavement surfaces will be measured on an each basis each time each rest area is cleaned.

BASIS OF PAYMENT

The unit price bid shall include the cost of all labor, materials and equipment necessary to complete the work. No separate payment will be made for maintenance and protection of traffic but this cost is to be included in the price bid for cleaning the bicycle path pavement surfaces. No payment will be made for cleaning at any rest area until Rest Area Removal of Litter and Rest Area Cleaning of Pavement is performed at a given location for the month specified.
