

**DESCRIPTION**

This work shall consist of furnishing and installing a sculpture in accordance with the contract documents and as directed by the Engineer.

**MATERIALS**

The sculpture shall be as specified in the plans unless otherwise approved by the Engineer after consultation with the regional landscape architect.

Material shall be as specified in the contract documents.

Shop Drawings shall be submitted at least 30 days prior to beginning any work, for approval by the Engineer. Shop Drawings will not be required if the sculpture is fabricated in strict adherence to the details indicated on the Contract Drawings.

**CONSTRUCTION DETAILS**

**Submittals.** Contractor shall submit for approval:

1. Shop Drawings -shall include the following:
  - a. locations of sculpture, hardware, and accessories.
  - b. materials, dimensions, sizes, weights, and finishes of components.
  - c. plans, elevations, sections, and other required installation and operational clearances, and details of anchorage and attachment.
2. Photographs: Color photographs of three similar past projects done by the sculptor.
3. Installation procedures and instructions for a typical sculpture.

**Samples.** At least 21 days prior to placing any sculpture, the Contractor shall provide the following samples for the Engineer's approval after consultation with the regional landscape architect:

1. Selection Samples: For each finish product specified, two complete sets of color chips representing full range of available colors and patterns.
2. Verification Samples: For each finish product specified, two samples, minimum size 150 mm square, representing actual product, color, and patterns.

If the Engineer determines that the samples do not meet the requirements, the Contractor shall produce others that meet the Engineer's approval.

**Installation.** Sculpture shall be installed true to location and grade as shown on the contract documents or as directed by the Engineer. The Contractor shall protect all parts of the sculpture and maintain it in an undamaged condition until completion and acceptance of the Contract. Any

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sections damaged at any time prior to final acceptance shall be repaired or replaced at no additional cost to the State.

**Touch-up & Repair** will be required for minor damage at abrasions sustained during transportation and installation. The repair shall not be visible from a distance of 0.9 meters.

**METHOD OF MEASUREMENT**

This work will be measured as the number of sculptures satisfactorily furnished and installed.

**BASIS OF PAYMENT**

The unit price bid shall include the cost of furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary to satisfactorily complete the work.
